- Support for Pre-Connected session for immediate browsing.
- Support for advanced printing capabilities.
- Support for Microsoft SQL server 2012 (SP2) on Windows sever 2012 & 2012 r2.
- Support for original print driver on Terminal Servers.
- Fast switching between remote and local sites.
- Enhanced security capabilities.
- The ability to block HTML5 content.
- The ability to send email notifications to System Administrators upon uploading a document.
- New server installation utility.
- The ability to receive email notification in case print-out fails.
- The ability to Auto-end RDP session when browser is closed.
- URL log was optimized.
- The ability to control CPU and Memory from one screen.

Bug Fixes

- Random flash content was not blocked.

- Chrome browser URL redirection inside didn't work in some network instructions.
- Chrome browser bookmarks weren't saved on server.
- Reconnect function wasn't supported.
- Jetro Clipboard crashed randomly.
- URL log was overloaded.
- Native Print Drivers weren't supported.
